Community Market

Angie Kuehl, Market Manager, shared a closer view of the “new” weekly market held at the CCHS east parking area each Saturday, 8 a.m. - 12 noon. She is also a member of the Illinois Farmers’ Market Association.

The Carbondale Community Farmers Market is unique in several respects. It is a registered not-for-profit organization. It accepts new vendors by application, with a three-category classification system: certified organic, sustainable, and conventional. It is the first market in the state to accept the “Link Card” (EBT), including \$1 and \$5 tokens. To preserve a safe setting, the Market allows no early sales.

She displayed the “Plant a Carrot, Build a Community” driveway markers. The Market is one of three in Illinois and approximately 100 in the USA participating in the “Build a Community” effort.

In response to questions, she also described her involvement as a beekeeper. She has 12 hives currently, but the number varies as swarms arrive, depart, divide, and otherwise change. She explained the simple process of removing a hive from a home or other unwanted location, then talked about effects of pesticides and herbicides of hives.
