RYE: Brian Suarez

Brian experienced a year in France, including a 12-day Euro Tour to Germany, Austria, Italy, Switzerland, and Czech Republic with 40 other students.

He presented his observations with a multi-media PowerPoint, his pin-laden sport coat, and a much-autographed French flag.

Brian stayed with four families during his RYE time, with varying mixes of "siblings." He noted differing ways that the host families lived their "family time" and commented on each family being so unique.

He reported significant changes within himself. He realized a self-awareness that resulted in confidence with his own identity. Also, he gained new perspective about his life in America compared with lifestyles in other countries, and he reported a new appreciation for Carbondale.

Brian noted similarities and differences of high schools in France versus CCHS. Prominent among differences is the high degree of specialization. Students choose among three major foci: Science, Literature, or Economics. Then, they mostly stay with the same people taking the same schedule of classes throughout their secondary education.

He expressed thanks to the club and Rotary International for the unforgettable opportunity.
