Treasury. YTD: Revenue-\$2519; Expense-\$318. Received: \$10269 (100 MWC). Balances: Checking-\$21892; Accts Rcvbl.-(517). Liabilities: \$3000 (CCHS scholarships), \$10269 (100 MWC). Unrestricted: \$8107.

100 Men Who Cook - Allocations. Club membership approved (voice vote -1 abstention) the following as one-time contributions: Good Samaritan Ministries-\$1268; Big Brother/Big Sister-\$1000; Lifesavers-\$1000; The Women's Center-\$500; Boys & Girls Club-\$500; This Able Veteran-\$500; Carbondale Splash Park-\$2500; "I Can Read"-500; Masonic Children's Home-\$1000; Pat's Kids:\$1000; Gumdrops-\$500.
