Downtown Development

City Manager **Kevin Baity** shared eye-catching pix of ideas for possible downtown development, comparing / contrasting certain current Carbondale sites with possible development opportunities.

During his travels in the Midwest, Ohio River Valley, and other states, Baity photographed sites and sights in other cities, then followed up with city officials to trace the background of the needs, opportunities, and outcomes.

His presentation precedes a series of open forum sessions in Carbondale for the next several months (all 6:30 p.m.):

The downtown development is defined approximately as (a) Illinois Avenue and University Avenue from SIUC to Willow Street and (b) University Avenue to Washington Street.
