100 Men Who Cook

ONB Region President **Jeff Speith** invited participation of the club for the 2015 edition of the now well-established event. He traced the origins, brief history, and current planning, emphasizing the previous record accomplishment of the Rotary clubs – more than \$62,000 in 2013. Further, he cited the importance of this year’s activities as much-needed support for This ABLE Veteran (TAV).

Old National Bank’s involvement with 100 MWC began with the Indiana sites, then was extended into Southern Illinois six years ago. Previous recipient organizations have included the Boys and Girls Club and area Kiwanis clubs as well as Rotary District 6510.

This year, the June 6 event is a joint effort of ONB and Rotary District 6510 for the benefit of the district’s signature charitable focus: TAV. Rotary clubs will be asked to seek more cooks, sign up for multiple tables, provide auction items, and serve as same-day volunteers.

The planning committee this year includes four-five Rotarians as well as the TAV representatives and the ONB staff. Rotarians are Steve Battiste, Terry Mathias, and Shane Carsrud (RCCB) and Phil Gillespie and John Streuter (RC-Carterville Area). During late winter and early spring months, they will be visiting D6510 Rotary clubs to promote the early summer event.
