RI: Global Scope

Olga Weidner shared information about the scope of Rotary International on the world stage. This serves as an introduction to “World Understanding Month” in Rotary. A paramount goal of RI is “Peace Through Understanding.”

RI established the “World Understanding” monthly theme in 1983, associated with RI’s anniversary date – Feb. 23 – also considered World Understanding and Peace Day.

She traced the origins and early history of RI’s global involvement. The first national convention was held in Chicago (1910). In 1912, the organization was renamed “The International Association of Rotary Clubs” at the convention in Duluth. The first Rotary club outside the USA: Winnipeg, Manitoba, Canada, 1910. Eight clubs were chartered in England and Ireland (1914); the 1921 International Convention was in Edinburgh, Scotland.

Weidner outlined other milestones of international scope through the early and middle decades of the twentieth century. Of special note was the 1940 “Universal Declaration of Human Rights” at Rotary’s International Convention in Cuba, which set the stage for Rotary’s oft-reported role in the chartering of the United Nations in San Francisco (1945) and establishment of the United Nations (1948).
