INTERACT: The Club Role

PP **Terry Mathias** shared an overview of establishing an Interact Club, emphasizing the role of the sponsoring Rotary Club as well.

Six Steps to Start an Interact Club

1. Establish Rotary Club support.
2. Identify prospective Interactors.
3. Invite prospective members to interest meetings.
4. Hold organizational meetings.
5. Complete the paperwork.
6. Hold an inaugural ceremony.

He reported the roles of several **key people**: faculty advisers, the Youth Services Committee chair, and a within-club Rotarian adviser. The last position is open for an interested club member to accept and fulfill.

Next, Terry highlighted the general **responsibilities** of the sponsoring Rotary club, such as the following:

- ◆ supporting the faculty advisers,
- ◆ holding an annual meeting of the Interact Club,
- ◆ supporting service activities, including joint activities,
- ◆ developing membership strategies,
- ◆ recognizing individual Interactor and club achievements,
- ◆ helping to publicize Interact club activities and projects,
- ◆ ... and much more.

Borrowing from the standard Interact Club constitution, he also outlined the many **goals** of a successful Interact club, such as recognizing and developing constructive leadership and personal integrity; encouraging and practicing thoughtfulness and helpfulness to others; building respect for the rights of others; enhancing life skills, such as time management, personal finance, self-development, etc.; and increasing knowledge and understanding of community, national, and world affairs, among others.
