Junior Sports: Football

Commissioners/Coaches **Jimi Bradley & Jeremy Summers** shared the narrative of the junior sports football program for some 75-125 youth in fourth to eighth grades. Three teams are fielded: 5th+6th grade, 7<sup>th</sup> grade, and 8<sup>th</sup> grade. Youth come from the CCHS-feeder schools, plus some from Du Quoin and St. Andrew schools.

More than a dozen (volunteer) coaches share the load. The conference is regional with nine teams. Great emphasis is placed on safety, including concussion-resistant helmets and other safety-oriented gear, even at somewhat higher cost.

Significant attention is given to the youth being good students and good citizens first. Parent volunteers, for example, guide homework completion before the youth can practice.

The current program is the fourth edition of this football program, developing from a 2008 start with support from the Elks, Eagles, and local churches, plus individual donors.

Pre-season camps focus on physical therapy, cardio conditioning, sports medicine, even nutrition, but not weightlifting that is inappropriate for the age range.
