RI: Helping with Ebola Response

Rotary International President Gary C.K. Huang and the Board of Directors just issued a statement expressing deepest concern and empathy for those countries and individuals impacted by the Ebola outbreak.

“We recognize that public health professionals and community health workers working on polio eradication, particularly in West Africa, will be called upon to help respond to the Ebola crisis.”

“Rotary continues to closely monitor the latest developments, and work with the World Health Organization, UNICEF, the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, and other partners to respond to both polio and Ebola. Fighting disease is a priority of our members.”

“Through our investments in the polio eradication infrastructure in Nigeria, the government was able to help stop the outbreak of Ebola. The polio surveillance network – used to monitor cases for polio – is being employed to identify and track suspected Ebola cases and has contributed to Nigeria’s successful response. It is important to remember that Nigeria is still one of three polio endemic countries and we must continue our efforts on eradicating polio to prevent new outbreaks.”

“Polio eradication efforts to boost the immunity of children in the area continue, and synchronized polio immunization campaigns were held in September across 18 west and central African countries during which 94 million children were immunized against polio.”

The Rotary Foundation

PP **George Waring** provided an up-close-and-personal overview of The Rotary Foundation: origins, mission, history, programs, and more, emphasizing the ABCs: **A**nnual **B**enevolent **C**ontributions.

One club goal for 2014-15 is 100% participation in "Every Rotarian, Every Year" [EREY]. By club vote, this outcome is achieved with a \$10/member contribution from dues.

Members are encouraged to help reach a second goal: 100% Sustaining Member Club recognition. This includes each member contributing at least \$100 to TRF by March 31. The \$10 EREY contribution already counts.

Waring explained the major funds: Annual Fund, Endowment Fund, and PolioPlus and other restricted giving. Annual Fund giving is used for three years to accrue interest for operation of The Rotary Foundation. In the third year, 50% of funds come back to the district as District Designated Funds; 50% to the World Fund.

Endowment Fund ... only the interest is used for programs. Further, if contributions are marked as "SHARE," then 50% are allocated for district use. Of course, gifts to PolioPlus and other restricted funds are used only for the designated purposes, as required by federal law.

PP George explained individual recognition: Paul Harris Fellow, PHF+, Paul Harris Society, Major Donor, Benefactor, and Bequest Society.

Waring also explained three grant programs: District, Global, and Packaged, with relevant details.
