RI has been seeking a new and improved web site with a clean, modern look and state-of-the-art features. Now it's ready.

Actually, two inter-related web sites exist: one for the public and one for the Rotary family. The member site, known as *My Rotary*, allows access to all that any Rotarian needs to conduct Rotary business. After creating an account and signing into the site, a member can (a) customize and share a profile; (b) join or start a discussion group; (c) find volunteers, partners, and even donations for a Rotary project; and (d) view a dashboard of valuable links, documents, and online communities. Access is also available by smart phone or tablet.

Coincidentally, District 6510 also is re-energizing its website. Assistant Governor (Area #2) Jill Pietrusinski is renovating the existing site for greater functionality. For example, chairs of district committees have recently been asked to contribute relevant data for project pages. As the project progresses, updates and details will be provided here.

On Sunday (8 Sept.), District Conference chairperson Mike Russell sent individualized messages to D6510 Rotarians about registering for the conference, 11-12 October. The message contains a direct link to registration, so even if you are still working through navigation in DaCdb, you can jump right to conference registration.
